Notice is hereby given that sealed Proposals will be received by the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority (NJSEA), P.O. Box 640, One DeKorte Park Plaza, Lyndhurst, New Jersey 07071 for the following:

DEVELOPMENT OF MEADOWLANDS DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION PLAN 2045

Proposals must be submitted in the Proposal Form contained in the Section 3 of the package and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope plainly marked on the outside with the name of project and the name of Respondent. Proposals will be received at the above address until 2:00 PM prevailing time, on **Tuesday, November 12, 2019**. Proposals will **not** be accepted after 2:00 PM on that day. The Request for Proposal (RFP) will be available for review on the NJSEA website (<https://www.njsea.com/public-notices/>) starting on **Tuesday, October 1, 2019, after 10:00 AM**. **Respondents must register their contact information with the NJSEA in order to receive notices and responses to questions regarding the RFP.** Contact information, as well as any technical and administrative questions regarding this RFP shall be submitted in writing to nmoini@njsea.com at or before **2:00 PM, Monday, October 21 2019**. The written responses to all questions will be circulated among all registered Respondents and posted on the NJSEA website on **Wednesday October 30, 2019**.

The purpose of this Project is to perform all work necessary to update the existing Meadowlands District Transportation Plan (MDTP), which was adopted in 2007 and projected for 2030 (MDTP 2030), and prepare the Meadowlands District Transportation Plan 2045 (MDTP 2045). The update will evaluate the District's transportation needs, incorporating the recent growth and transportation improvement projects in the District within the past twelve years. The update will review the candidate transportation improvements recommended in the MDTP 2030, and develop project recommendations that are needed to address existing transportation needs and support future District development over a time frame that reaches to the year 2045. The update will estimate the cost of the recommended transportation improvements and update the transportation mitigation assessment framework, including fee calculation methodology and VMT factors, to assure fair and sustainable growth in the District.

The RFP Documents contain specific requirements for the submission of a proposal. The attention of all Respondents is particularly called to the State requirements noted in Section 3.00 of the RFP. If awarded a contract, your company/firm shall be required to comply with the requirements of **N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27**. The NJSEA reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals and to waive minor Proposal defects.
